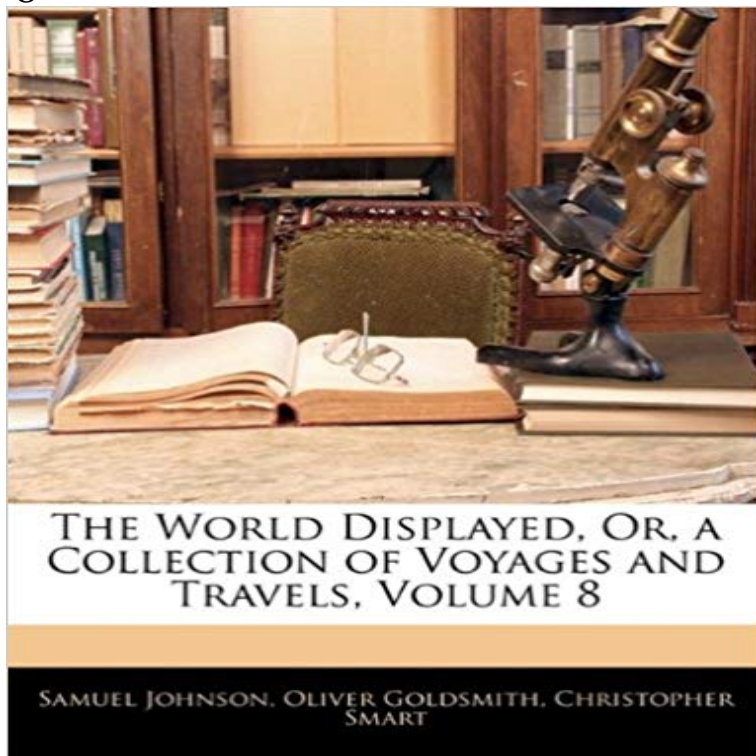


The World Displayed, Or, a Collection of Voyages and Travels, Volume 8
