It was inspired by the financial scandals of the early 1870s. Trollope had returned to England from abroad, and was appalled by the greed and dishonesty those scandals exposed. This novel was his rebuke. It shows how that greed and dishonesty pervaded the commercial, political, moral, and intellectual life of that era. *The American Senator* (1877) American Senator Elias Gotobed for the fictional state of Mikewa hopes to learn about England and the English during a visit to Britain. He discovers the irrationality of Englishmen, British justice and questionable aspects of English life. Meanwhile, the novel immerses the readers in the somewhat desperate search for a husband by both Mary Masters, the daughter of an attorney, and Arabella Trefoil, whose mother is determined to ensure her own financial security by arranging a proper husband for the scheming Arabella. *Castle Richmond* Set at the beginning of the Irish famine, *Castle Richmond* involves the competition of two English cousins for the hand of Clara Desmond, the noble but poor daughter of the widowed Countess of Desmond. About The Author Victorian-era author Anthony Trollope (1815–1882) was a British novelist with an interest in politics and current affairs. Among his fans are Sir Alec Guinness who reportedly never journeyed without a Trollope novel. Among his best known works are *The Chronicles of Barsetshire* Series, six novels set in the fictitious English county of Barsetshire (located near where Dorset lies) and its cathedral town of Barchester.
