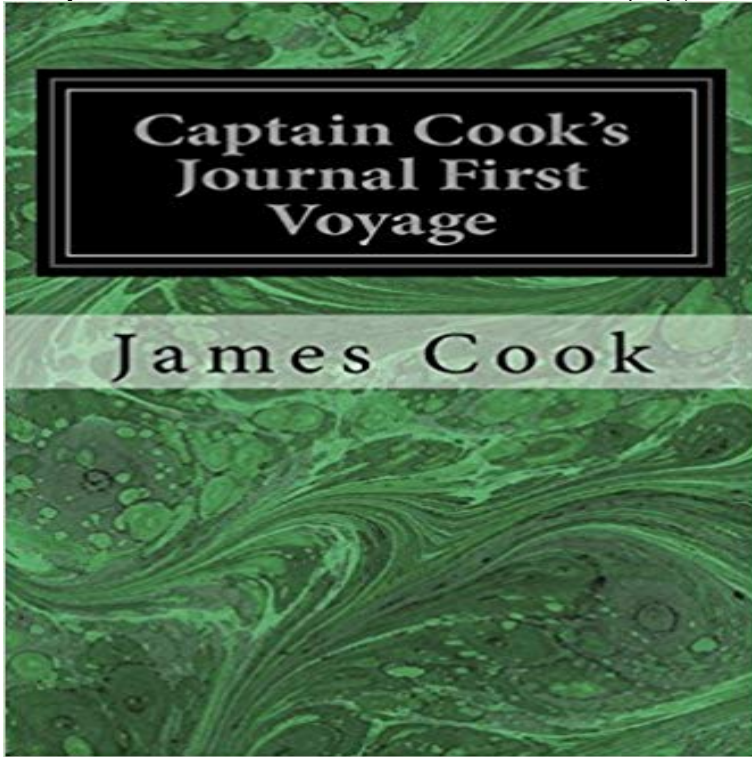


Captain Cooks Journal First Voyage
