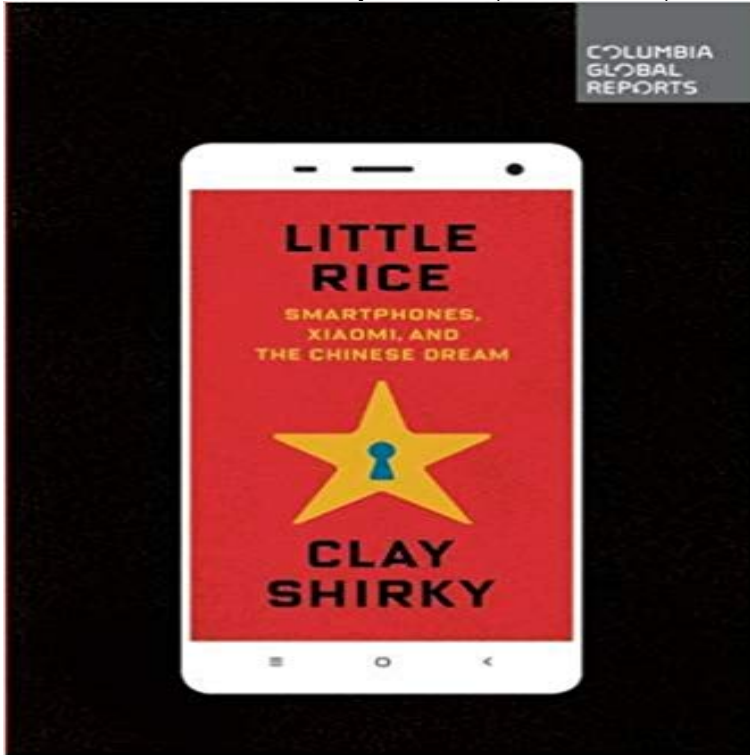


# Little Rice: Smartphones, Xiaomi, and the Chinese Dream
