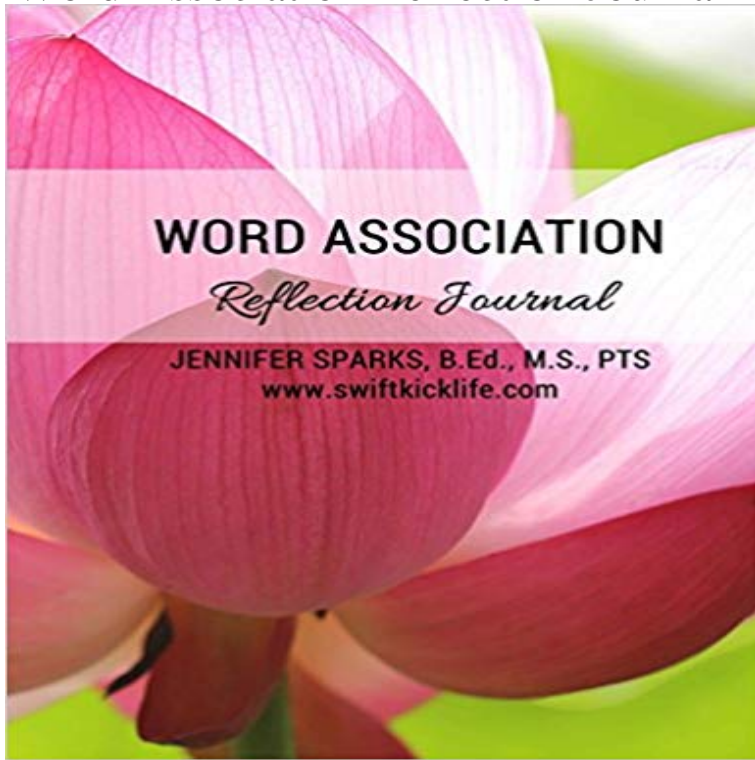


# Word Association Reflection Journal
