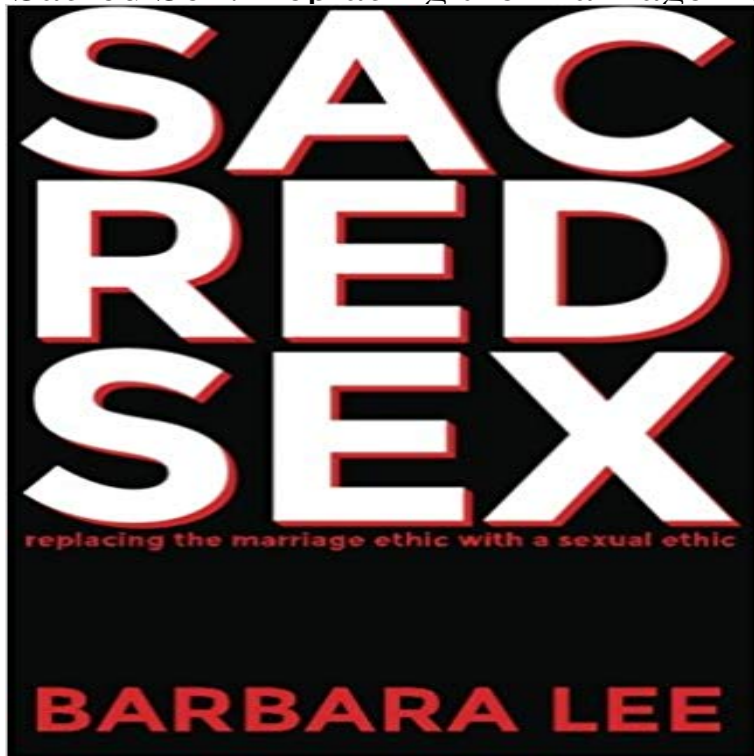


Sacred Sex: Replacing the Marriage Ethic with a Sexual Ethic
