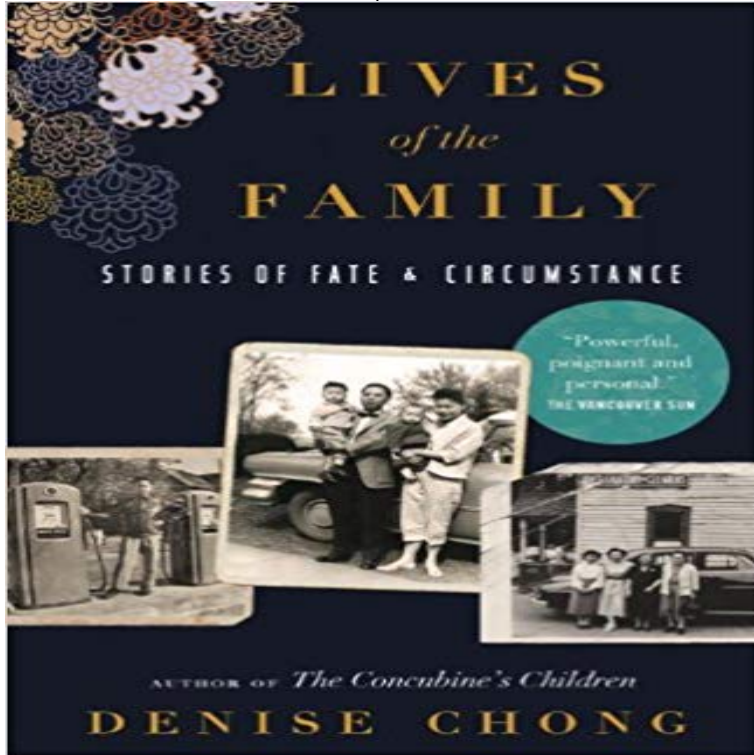


Lives of the Family: Stories of Fate and Circumstance

This book of overlapping stories explores the trajectory of a universal immigrant experience, one of looking in the rear view mirror while at the same time, travelling toward an uncertain future.
