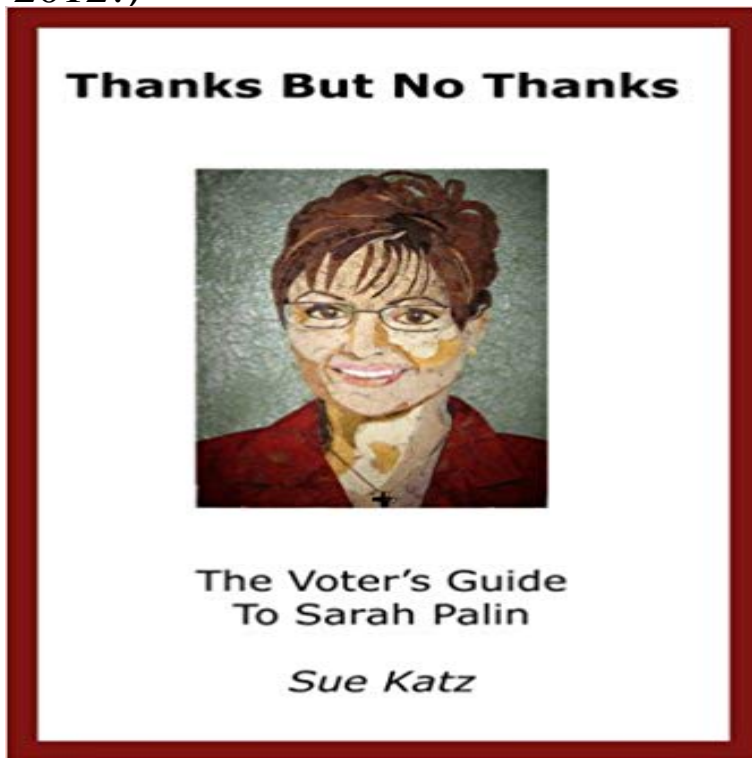


Thanks But No Thanks: The Voters Guide to Sarah Palin (Get a Jump on 2012!)
